

The Weather Is Warming Up

Some seasonal reminders for everyone:

- Before you bring home potted plants or start your garden, be sure to check to see if they are toxic to your furry friends. The ASPCA has more information here: https://www.aspca.org/pet-care/animal-poison-control/toxic-and-non-toxic-plants
- If you plan to start opening windows with the nicer weather, please double check your screens to make sure they are sturdy and have no tears.
- Keep your pets away from freshly fertilized grass for at least 24 hours after treating your lawn.

Does My Pet Have Allergies?

Did you know that pets, like people, can suffer from seasonal allergies? If so, you may notice them start to become more itchy. You may also see your pet rubbing their face more on furniture or with their paws. If you notice anything like that, please give us a call to schedule an exam with one of our veterinarians to rule out other problems and get your pet some relief. Some pets need to stay on allergy medication all year round, and some pets need it just in the springtime. At Sand Creek Animal Hospital, our patients are most commonly treated for allergies with either Apoquel, an oral medication, or Cytopoint, an injection given by a veterinarian.
